The International IT-BPM Summit (IIS) is the flagship event of the IT and Business Process Association of the Philippines (IBPAP), held annually to spotlight the progress, innovation, and impact of the Philippine IT-BPM industry. It is a platform to showcase the sector's role in shaping the country's economic future—through job creation, global competitiveness, and digital transformation.

IIS brings together the industry's key stakeholders—business leaders, global experts, policymakers, and the academe—for two days of insight-driven discussions, strategic networking, and shared action. It is where the most pressing issues facing the industry are addressed, and where emerging opportunities are explored through the lens of both global trends and local context.

As the largest and most influential IT-BPM conference in the Asia-Pacific region, IIS gathers over 1,000 participants each year, making it a critical venue for dialogue, partnership, and long-term industry positioning.
